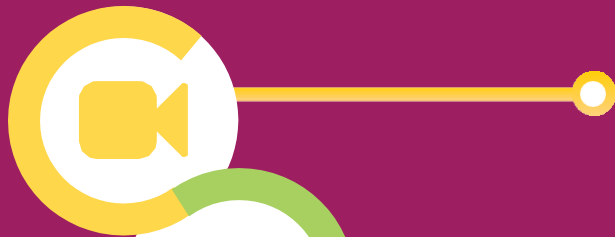


4 WAYS TO BE A #ClinicalTrialsChampion

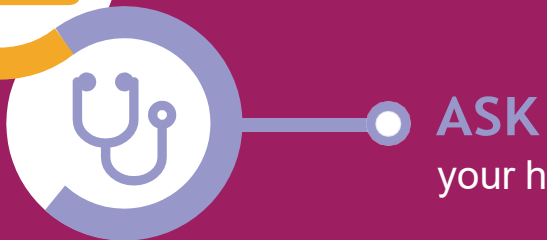
